



WHAT IS PALESTINE?

From antiquity to the Ottoman conquest, via the British occupation, the founding of the State of Israel, the Israeli-Arab wars, the « intifadas » in Gaza, the Oslo Accords, the colonization of the West Bank, and right up to October 7, 2023, the history of Palestine is an international time bomb; the most disputed territory in contemporary history. This 3-part documentary series offers the keys to understanding the historical, geographical and political situation of Palestine, based on never-before-seen archival footage, experts and characters steeped in the realities of the Palestinian territory. It has a strong educational aim: to offer a clear narrative so that the history of Palestine ceases to be a blind spot in the history of the Middle East.
